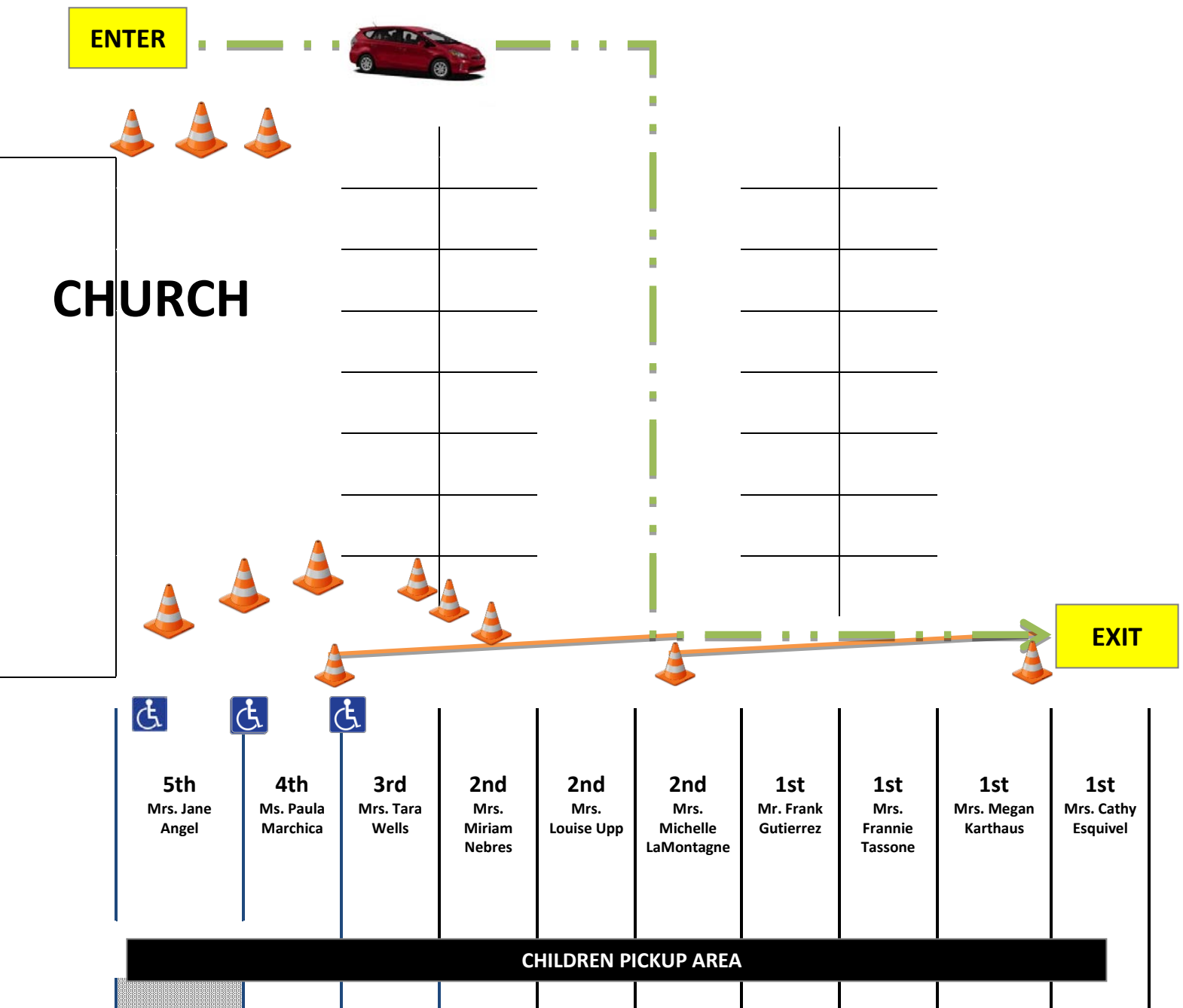
**SAFETY FIRST: Parking Lot Process**
